### INTRO QUESTIONS:

- What encouraged or challenged you from the sermon and/or the daily exercises this week?
- Can you think of someone who wouldn't naturally have a lot of social influence but has actually made a huge impact in the world?
- Why do you think God so often uses the unlikely outcasts to do great work?

### KEY PASSAGES:

- **1 Corinthians 1:18-25** - What examples can you see in our world today of this passage at work?
- **Acts 4:13** - Have you ever doubted your ability to make an impact for Jesus because you lack theological training? Does this verse affect your views on that?
- **John 4:42** - What can we learn from this woman's role in introducing her village to Jesus? Does it take any pressure off of you to realize she didn't have to have all the answers or convince them, but simply introduced them to Jesus?

### GROUP DISCUSSION:

- When have you personally been impacted by someone you wouldn't have expected?
- Who do you see in your world who is overlooked or doesn't have the influence you think they could have? What could you do to help amplify their voice?
- When have you seen someone with plenty of positional influence not have the kind of impact they wanted to have?
- What could this group do to help look for and elevate the voices of "the least of these" so that Jesus can be made even more famous?

### WEEKLY APPLICATION:

- On page 82, we were challenged to write down the name of someone we wanted to influence for Jesus and a step we could encourage them to take towards Jesus. Who did you write down and how have you encouraged them this week?
