#### **Intro Questions:**

- What encouraged or challenged you from the sermon and/or the daily exercises this week?
- Besides Jesus, who is someone you would consider one of the greatest of all time? Why?
- Who is someone our world considers great? How well do you think they model this idea of servant leadership?

## **Key Passages:**

- 1 Peter 5:2-3 Have you ever served a leader like that? How was that experience?
- Matthew 20:24-28 Have you ever witnessed people jockeying for positions of influence like this? How would following Jesus' description of servant leadership have helped them?
- **Philippians 2:3-11** How does modeling Jesus' attitude towards others actually give us more influence?

# **Group Discussion:**

- Have you seen someone attempt to be a great leader but go about it in the wrong way? What did that do for their leadership?
- Who is the best leader you've ever served under? Who is the worst leader you've ever served under? What were some of the key differences between the two?
- Do you think it's a bad thing to want influence or leadership? Why or why not?
- Who do you have influence over that you could humbly serve this week? What will you do?
