

WEEK 7 | GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

CONNECT

• This week, we are talking about Jesus being THE WAY! Think of Jesus as your GPS to God. Jesus is your Navigator. To know Jesus is to know God! While it's possible some of our GPSs today might not be completely accurate or reliable, Jesus is always accurate and reliable. Have you ever been lost while using a GPS? What did you do? How did you react? How does it feel to know that Jesus is always reliable?

CONSIDER

• What was encouraging or challenging from the sermon and/or daily devotions this week?

CHRIST

Read John 14:1-7.

- The opening verse is "Do not let your heart be troubled." What are some things that consistently trouble your heart? How can you be praying about this with Jesus and partnering better with Him to know how to handle these troubles?
- Jesus says, "I am the way, the truth and the life." Jesus is telling us that He is giving us a
 better way to live our lives and to follow Him. Our everyday lives should follow His example,
 and by doing this we will be able to have eternal life in God's full presence. We know that if
 God tells us this, He MEANS it! Read the following verses to be reminded of how God
 always does what He says He will and discuss:
 - o Genesis 9:8-16
 - o Psalm 32:8
 - o Isaiah 41:10
 - o John 16:33
- This weekend, we talked about how eternal life is NOW, not just LATER. If we lived as if eternal life is now, how would we live?
- This weekend, Nate asked the question: Why is Jesus worth following if He's no longer on earth today? What was the answer to that question?

 - Following Jesus

 - Joining the mission of Jesus
