#### **INTRO QUESTIONS:**

- What encouraged or challenged you from the sermon and/or the daily exercises this week?
- Have you ever known someone who believed God could never forgive them? How did those conversations go?
- Have you ever felt there was something in your past that God couldn't forgive you? How did you come to terms with the true magnitude of God's grace?

## **KEY PASSAGES:**

- Romans 8:1-2 Who do you know who really needs to hear and internalize this passage?
- 1 John 3:19-24 How can this passage help set a guilt-ridden person's conscience at ease?

- How has the Church inadvertently reinforced this belief over the years? How do you think our church does with this?
- Who in your life seems far from God but might be surprisingly open to Jesus' invitation to follow Him?
- How can you incorporate more of "the sick" into your regular social circle?
